## Special Recall Election Meeting August 7, 2018

In chapter 44, section 8-21 of recall of elective officials of subdivisions paragraph 3, special recall election should be held no sooner that 95 days and no later than 105 days following the date the filling officer certifies petition valid and sufficient. She than states that August 9<sup>th</sup> recall election is passed the 105 days.

Mayor Schatz talked with City Attorney Walter Lipp, and Elections Specialist from North Dakota Secretary of State's Office Lee Ann Oliver which they both stated we should go along with the recall election on August 9<sup>th</sup>.

Auditor Fiedler stated she had also been talking with Lee Ann Oliver and she told her the same thing, to go along with the recall election.

Councilmember Fiedler makes a motion to go along with the recall election as long as the state/county auditor say it's still ok, Howard seconded it. Motion carried.

Presser makes a motion to adjourn, Laib seconded it. Motion carried.
